EACH ONE TEACH ONE

Many people set goals for themselves this time of the year. New Year's resolutions are common. As Christians, we need to set some goals for the coming year. Each one of us needs to teach one. If this is accomplished each congregation could possibly double in attendance and the church of our Lord would add souls. "And the things that thou hast heard of me among many witnesses, the same commit thou to faithful men, who shall be able to teach others also" (2 Timothy 2:2). This is a biblical principle which if applied, works. This is the carrying out of the great commission. Each Christian who has been a member of the Lord's church should be able to teach someone. Paul wrote in Hebrews 5:12-13, "For when for the time ye ought to be teachers, ye have need that one teach you again which be the first principles of the oracles of God; and are become such as have need of milk, and not of strong meat. For every one that useth milk is unskilled in the word of righteousness: for he is a babe. But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil."

One might make an excuse that they were unable to stand in the pulpit and preach or stand before a class and teach. Many indeed are not able to do either one, but that does not preclude them from teaching. In order to carry out the command to go teach one must prepare themselves for the service. Like David in Ps. 119:11, "Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee." Start by memorizing scripture that you can use in talking to someone about the gospel. If young people will do this, those scriptures will help them order their lives as God would have them.

"But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts: and be ready always to give an

answer to every man that asketh you a reason of the hope that is in you with meekness and fear" (1 Peter 3:15). What should be our goal now and for always? To set the Lord God as Savior in our minds in order to give a reason for our hope not only to those who ask, but to anyone we may come in contact with. Once we are prepared to teach, if we can't preach publicly or in a classroom setting, how can we teach? We can invite others to our worship service. We should not be timid to do so. "For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek" (Romans 1:16). There are literally hundreds of well-written pamphlets that tell the sweetest story that man has ever heard. Pick out several and keep them with you in your car or at home. (Make sure you have a phone number or address on it so if someone wishes to respond, they have a way.) Give these out to people you meet daily. Send cards to visitors who worship with you. Send cards or letters to people in the community who are undergoing difficult times. Be sure and make them special with a few personal words. Talk to the lost and to the erring. Each soul is valuable. Use any means available to contact as many as you can. Jesus commanded us, "Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned" (Mark 16:15-16). Go ye means go me. Each one teach one; God will give the increase.
