that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven (Matthew 5:14-16).

Today, when we think about light, a number of man-made products come to mind. Thinking about such products, there are two types of light we need to avoid being, as Christians.

The first is UV (ultraviolet) light—often called black light. We do not actually see its light. Rather, we see the reflection of the light on an object that contains phosphorus. UV light is used in automotive HVAC to detect leaks in the system. It is used by crime scene investigators to detect blood and other bodily fluids. Therefore, it is often used to detect a fault or a contamination. While our Christian light will reveal the error of the ungodly, it should not be our sole purpose to magnify others' faults.

The second is neon light. Neon lights have long been used for display, show, and attraction. These lights draw attention to themselves, and are not used to actually see the way or path. While

others are to see our Christian lights, we do not let them shine to draw attention to ourselves. Rather, we let our lights shine to draw attention to our God.

Jesus used two illustrations in Matthew 5:14-16. He used a city on a hill. It is up high and cannot be missed. Furthermore, he used an oil lamp (similar to our title image) placed on the one stand in a onelamp house. Christians are the only light this world has. Yes, Christ is the light of the world (John 8:12; 9:5), but He has chosen to use His followers to show His light (Matthew 5:14-16). We are not merely reflections of His light, but the fixtures that house His light so that all the world can see. Let us make sure we are not UV lights, only seeking to find fault and contamination in others, nor neon lights, drawing attention to ourselves, but Christian lights. To God be the glory.
